On Monday 4th August there will be a Service of Prayers of Commemoration, Remembrance and Reconciliation in St Mary's Church at 9.30am and St Andrew's Church at 10.30am. The Churches will then be open until 6pm. There will be prayers and poems available for anyone who wants to pause and reflect on this 100th anniversary of World War 1.

On Monday 25th August 2014, Bank Holiday Monday, St Albans Diocese will celebrate its centenary with a Festival Day of Fun and Praise. The event and all activities at the College Equestrian Centre at Keysoe, north of Bedford are free.
